Academic Events

1. Instrument install under the Newton Bhabha Project :

The solar collectors (Phycofeeds Ltd., UK) of worth around £9500 (INR 8 lacs) have been received from Cranfield University to Department of Pure and Applied Physics and



installed at the rooftop of academic block of the University. The instrument will be used to convert microalgae to biofuels using solar energy. Dr. Namrata Sengar coordinate the collaborative research work, as University representative.


2. Patent:

Patent office of Indian government granted a patent in the name of Prof. Ashu Rani, Dipti Jain and Chitralekha Khatri on 23rd March, 2017, which will be valid for 20 years. The patent was applied on 2nd June, 2010, in which they develop green catalyst using Kota stone slurry and fly ash that will be utilised by Pharma and other industries.

3. Research Projects / External Funding : International projects:

Two projects (entitled as *Internet of things-Smart Remote solar PV lab* and *Self-cleaning surface coatings for solar photovoltaic and thermal systems to minimise water wastage in cleaning*), have been sanctioned for funding by Global Challenges Research Fund, UK each worth £20,000.00 . Two UK universities were acted as a lead partner (Dr. Satheesh Krishnamurthy and Dr. Tim Drysdale of Open





University UK and Dr. Manish Tiwari, University College London, UK.) along with Dr. Namrata Sengar as Indian partner of the projects. The projects aims to develop the open access remote PV laboratory for educational purposes for solar energy students of University of Kota. It will be useful to solve the problem of dust accumulation and cleaning of solar photovoltaic panels and solar reflectors, thus paving way for promotion of solar systems in these fields .

4. MOU:

University of Kota signed one Memorandum of Understanding with Dr. B. R. Ambedkar foundation, Mundla, Jaipur on 30th June 2017. Under the MOU, the Research / study will be done for propagating the ideology and thoughts of *Bharat Ratan* Dr. B. R. Ambedkar. The series of Workshop seminar, conferences, lectures, etc , will be conducted to promote the philosophy of Dr. Ambedkar. The PhD. Degree would be awarded on the work done by the Dr. Ambedkar on social sciences, political sciences, public Administration, Economics , philosophy, law, etc, subjects. An entrance test would be organised for the students, who wants to pursue the above mentioned degree and selected students will get the scholarships.

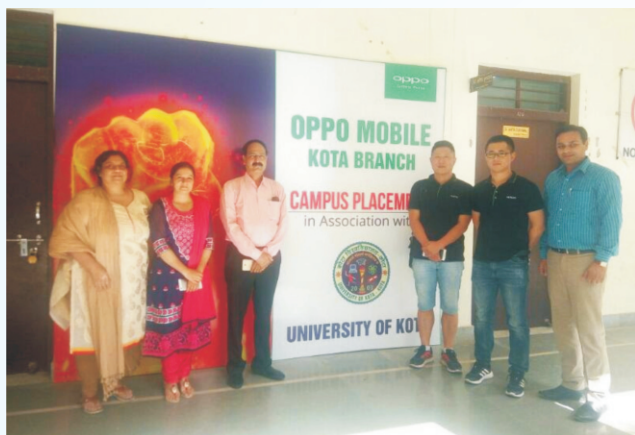
Placement News
