Information of Ph.D. Course Work Programme, 2015-16

1. The course work is compulsory to all the candidates and it will take place from April 21,2016.
2. The course work shall be for a minimum period of one semester and would be covered within 90 working days (including classes, Lectures, Laboratory work, etc.) **and 75% attendance will be compulsory for a candidate to appear in the examination for the first paper which will be held after the course work is over.** The attendance of the first paper shall be marked by the Coordinator where as the attendance for the second paper shall be maintained by the Supervisor/Department concerned.
3. The course work shall include two papers. The first paper shall be of maximum 100 marks consisting of Research Methodology and Computer Applications. Faculty-wise syllabus of this paper along with the examination scheme is available on the website of University. Minimum passing marks for first paper will be 40%. The subject-wise curriculum for Second paper shall be designed by the concerned Department/Supervisor as per the requirement and it would be focused on the following points.
 - (a) The candidates are required to review some relevant books, research articles as suggested by the supervisors.
 - (b) The candidates from Science subject shall be assigned laboratory work also to learn the relevant research techniques.
 - (c) The candidates especially from Arts, Humanities, Law, Education and Social Sciences along with Commerce shall be assigned to prepare relevant tools of data collection.
 - (d) Tasks/assignments shall be evaluated by the Department concerned.
 - (e) The result of this paper will be declared on qualitative grading basis i.e. Excellent, Good, Satisfactory and Poor.
 - (f) The candidate obtaining 'Poor' grade in the second will have to go for new tasks/assignments, i.e. shall be treated as failed in the second paper.
 - (g) The candidates are required to qualify separately in the first paper by scoring minimum 40% marks and by scoring minimum satisfactory grade in the second paper.
 - (h) On the basis of marks obtained in the first paper and the performance in the second paper the University shall provide a certificate to the candidates.
 - (i) The candidates who are already employed shall be required to produce No-objection certificate (NOC) from the Head of the concerning institution allowing for the course work. If they fail to do so they will not be allowed to undertake the Ph.D. course work.
4. After successful completion of the course work, the candidates registered for Ph.D. will proceed for thesis work under the allotted supervisors.
5. Those candidates who have already completed their course work for M.Phil will be exempted from the course work.
6. The syllabus for the first paper will be common for the subjects of Arts, Humanities, Social Science, Commerce and Law faculty whereas, the syllabus for the subjects of Science faculty will be common. The faculty-wise syllabus is available on the website of University.
7. The venue for theory and practical classes shall be the Seminar Hall, Saraswati Bhawan of the University of Kota.
